## ***Meeting Minutes***

March 11, 2025

6:00pm

The meeting was called to order and the roll was taken. Board members Todd Biggs, Chad Christian and Sonda Price were present. The board approved the minutes from the February meeting and with no public comments, Director Elkins began with program updates. Elkins stated that basketball had completely ended and the regional all-star tournament that Rogersville hosted this year was the previous weekend. Elkins commented how great the event turned out with teams from Morristown, Greeneville and Cocke County visiting and playing games across two days. Elkins complimented the staff that worked that weekend and how instrumental they were to the success of the event. Elkins then mentioned that baseball and softball registrations had ended and practices would be starting in a couple of weeks just after spring break. He said that numbers were slightly down overall but still had a good turnout. Elkins stated that the MovingU fitness class had its last session but would resume again in April along with the return of the youth athletic training program that had started in the fall. In grant updates, Elkins stated that the playground equipment was still on track to be installed sometime around the end of March or early April and that city crews had been working to prepare the site. Elkins then mentioned that bid packets were out for the construction of the pickleball courts and that sealed bids would be opened on March 27. With no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
