The regular business meeting of the Town of Rogersville Board of Mayor and Aldermen was held Tuesday, May 8, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Boardroom at City Hall. All members present.

Motion by Mark DeWitte second by Eloise Edwards to accept April minutes as presented. All voted Aye.

Motion by Mark DeWitte second by Sonda Price to approve closure of Main Street on June 9, 2018 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Depot St to Church St for Vintage Fair. All voted Aye.

Motion by Bill Henderson second by Eloise Edwards approving report that Street Dept. had chosen UniFirst bid to supply their uniforms. All voted Aye.

Motion by Bill Henderson second by Brian Hartness permission to apply for the Boyd Foundation Dog Park Grant. All voted Aye.

Motion by Brian Hartness second by Bill Henderson giving Mayor permission to sign contract with TDOT for highway maintenance inside the city limits of Rogersville. All voted Aye.
